- Built-in support for Zero Trust security principles

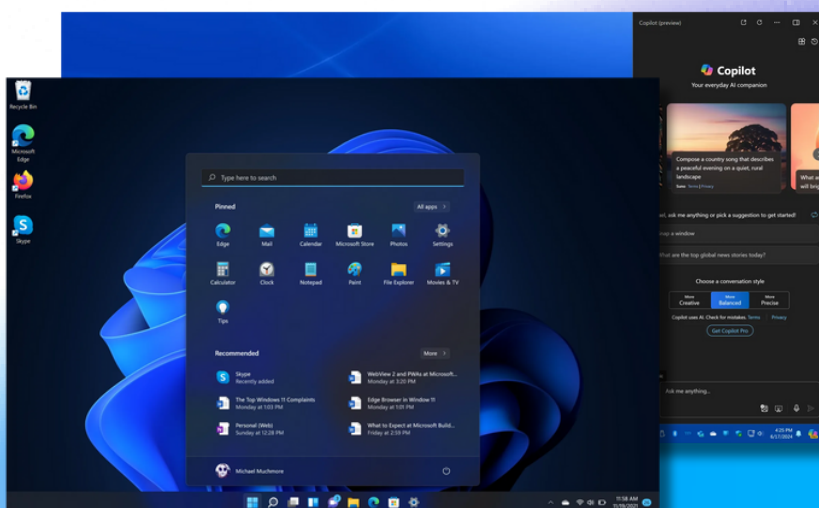
